
OHSA INAUGURAL WORLD SHOW JUDGE SADDLE SEAT AND GAITED

After moving to California, Michael owned and Exhibited several High point Tennessee Walking Horses: All The Money -Regional High point Halter Mare, An Heir About Him international 3 Gait Grand Champion Walking Horse, Silver Maple Shimmy- ASHA Regional High Point Model Champion Saddlebred Mare and multiple Champion Road Hackney Pony Northland Summer Storm.
